I. CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

INITIAL CLEANING

- 1. Remove all surface soil, debris, sand and grit with a vacuum.
- 2. Scrub floor with a neutral detergent.
- 3. Pick up solution with a wet vacuum, rinse with clean water and allow to dry thoroughly.
- 4. This process maybe done in one or two steps with an industrial floor cleaner.

DAILY/REGULAR CLEANING

- 1. Sweep or vacuum floor to remove surface soil, debris, sand and grit.
- 2. Damp mop the floor
- 3. This process may be done in one or two steps with an industrial floor cleaner.
- 4. Allow floor or dry thoroughly.

INTERIM MAINTENANCE

- 1. Vacuum floor thoroughly.
- 2. Aggressively scrub the floor with a neutral detergent. Use the rotary scrubber or industrial floor cleaner.
- 3. Vacuum any remaining soiled solution with a wet/dry vacuum.
- 4. Allow floor to dry thoroughly.

RESTORATIVE MAINTENANCE

- 1. Vacuum floor thoroughly.
- 2. Scrub using a rotary scrubber or an industrial floor cleaner. and neutral cleaner.
- 3. Pick up solution with wet vacuum or steam vacuum.
- 4. Allow floor to dry thoroughly.

II. Equipment Specifications

STEAM VACUUM MACHINE	Includes a scrubber and vacuum.
Power Scrubber	430 mm rotary floor buffer with mounted detergent tank and feed line to the brush. A circular brush attac - ment should be used.
WET/DRY SHOP VACUUM UNIT	Power Unit: Minimum 1.7 hp commercial unit, 7.0 amp, 120V AC, 50/60 Hz two stage bypass motor. Tank Capacity: 10-25 gallon, lined stainless steel or polypropylene. Accessories: Extension wand with a 150 mm to 300 mm in pickup nozzle, crevice tool, heavy-duty extension cord.
DETERGENT	Similar to any Hoover SteamVac model with scrubber and vacuum.

IMPORTANT MAINTENANCE TIPS

- Use high CFM vacuum to pick up dust.
- For large areas, use the industrial floor cleane.
- Dilute the detergents with water per the manufacturer's instructions; use higher concentrations for stubborn stains or hard to clean areas.
- Rinse, wet vacuum or mop up any detergent residue when cleaning the floo .
- For gum, use generic gum remover, however, any solvent-based product should be rinsed well with water to avoid damaging floo .
- **DO NOT** use an Auto Scrubber with a squeegee attachment. It tends to not pick up all of the dirty water solution and leaves a film of diluted di ty water on the tiles.
- **DO NOT** use petroleum or citrus based detergents.
